Organised by the Centre of Resilience for Social Justice at the University of Brighton with Boingboing and HeadStart Blackpool.

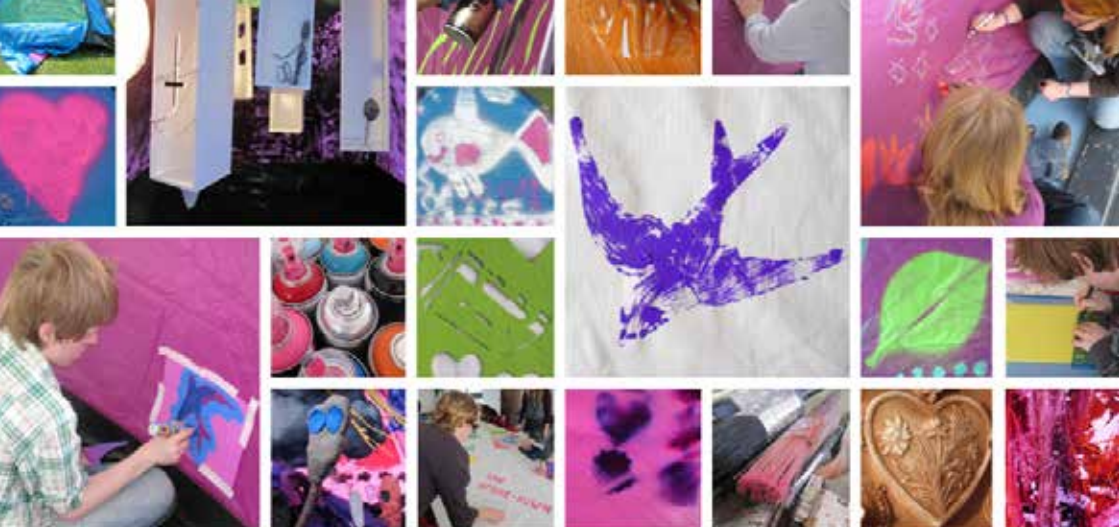
